Equally speaking, we do appreciate your concerns of Sudan Government exploiting the declared ceasefire period for building up of forces, redeployment and going for arms-shopping spree for the potential renewal of military offensives should the ceasefire collapse. This renewed armament is corroborated by the recent buying of highly technical fighter aircrafts and missiles from Russia.

We cordially acknowledge your long-standing efforts, dedication and concerns for the welfare of Sudanese people during the long years of protracted civil wars in Sudan that began in 1983.
